

Game Rules



Facilitator: Optional

Duration: 15 minutes or more

Number of players: 1 to 4 (playing independently)

Target audience: Grades 3 and 4

Setup

The facilitator places the answer card for the chosen level face down on the table and passes a game board, a pile of reading cards (for example, four cards), and 19 tokens to each player¹.

Game Play

1. Each player takes the reading card from the top of their pile. They read the clues describing the mystery character and progressively eliminate, using the tokens, the characters that do not match the descriptions. The mystery character is the last remaining character.

¹ The facilitator may replace the tokens with a dry-erase marker (not included) to eliminate characters.

2. Each player confirms their answer using the corresponding number on the answer card and moves on to the next reading card. The facilitator may rotate the cards between the players once they have completed those in their piles.

Variation: Playing in pairs

One player reads the clues while the other listens carefully and progressively eliminates characters.

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
